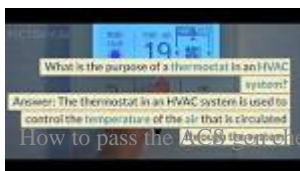

**Can AC induction motor generate electricity?** A regular AC induction motor usually can be used as a generator, without any internal modifications.

**Why are AC induction motors good?** An ac induction motor is much easier to control than a dc motor. The use of an ac induction motor requires no commutation, which means that the rotor does not need to be switched between different poles. This simplifies the design of the controller.

**How does an AC induction motor work?** The magnet fields induced within the rotor are attracted to the magnetic field being produced by the stator, following it as it rotates with each half-cycle of alternating current. This type of motor is called an induction motor because the magnetic field created in the stator induces a magnetic field in the rotor.

The squirrel cage design is the most common type of induction motor because they are self-starting, reliable, and economical. In this design, the rotor looks similar to a hamster wheel or 'squirrel cage', thus the name.
