**What is the highest grade in Hkdse exam?** Results are reported in five grades (a-e) on the HKDSE certificate, with grade 'e' being the lowest and grade 'a' being the highest. Achievement below 'e' is designated as 'Ungraded'.

**How long is dse paper 3?** The time allowed for the whole paper is approximately 2 hours. Candidates will be allowed one hour and fifteen minutes to complete Part B after the end of the listening input.

**What is tested in English Paper 3?** Paper 3 is intended to test the candidates' ability to communicate in writing. Communication is established at different levels of intelligibility, correctness accuracy, fluency, pleasantness and the originality shown by the candidates.

**What is a good GPA in Hong Kong?**

**What are level 3 questions in English?** Level 3 questions focus on applying and evaluating information. Gathering and recalling information. These questions can be answered with yes, no, or specific information found in written material, lectures, movies, etc.

**How many marks is English paper 1 question 3?** As the question is only worth 8 marks, you are only expected to spend approximately 10 minutes writing your answer to this question! Do not spend more time than this on this question as this means you will have less time to answer the higher mark questions at the end of the paper!

**What dictionary do Japanese people use?** Japanese language dictionaries. Kokugo jiten/jisho (????/?? "national language dictionary") means "Japanese–Japanese dictionary, monolingual Japanese dictionary". This "national language" term kokugo, which Chinese borrowed as guoyu, usually refers to the Japanese language as taught in Japanese schools.

**How many words are there in the Japanese dictionary?**

**What is the most accurate Japanese English dictionary?** Jisho.org may be the most popular English/Japanese dictionary online, and for good reason. It is powered by WWWJDIC, a comprehensive online search tool created by Prof. Jim Breen at Monash University. (Many find Jisho to be more user-friendly, but I love the simplicity of WWWJDIC personally.)

**What are 5 words that originated in Japanese but are now used in English?**

**How many words is considered fluent in Japanese?** For the most advanced test available, you will also need to know 2,000 kanji and 10,000 vocabularies. That's a huge jump! To give you a better idea, the average Japanese adult knows between 25,000 and 30,000 words. Don't worry, if you just want to reach fluency, you will need to know around 3,000 – 5,000 words.

**Why do Japanese say so many English words?** After World War II Japan aspired to creating a country similar in economic and technological progression to the United States. Hence, through their desire to emulate the American way of life, the Japanese people began, perhaps unconsciously, to use more English words in their own language.

**What percentage of Japanese is English words?** Then, beginning in the sixteenth century, as Japan began to interact with merchants and missionaries from the West, loanwords from European languages began to enter the Japanese language. Today, most loanwords assimilated into Japanese, about 80 percent of them, come from English.

**What is the most popular Japanese word?** (Kon'nichiwa) which means "Hello" in Japanese. This is one of the most common words in Japanese and a great way to start a conversation with someone from Japan.

**Why does Japanese use so many loan words?** Words are taken from English for concepts that do not exist in Japanese, but also for other reasons, such as a preference for English terms or fashionability – many gairaigo have Japanese near-synonyms. In the past, more gairaigo came from other languages

besides English.

### **What is the most used language in Japanese?**

**How do you say "no" in Japanese politely?** Let's start by looking at the most basic word for "no." In Japanese, the polite way to say "no" is "???" (Iie). Regardless, ??? (Iie) is still rarely used as a way to refuse, even in formal situations. It is the most straightforward, blunt way of doing it, while the casual way of saying "no" is ?? (iya).

**What is the 80/20 rule in Japanese?** The 80-20 Rule To boil it down the idea is that 20% of the efforts bring in 80% of the results. In the context of Japanese you only need to know about 20% of the language to be able to get by 80% of the time. Or at least for the core 80% of daily life.

**How many years does it take to speak Japanese fluently?** However, many experts believe it takes between 4 to 6 months of dedicated study to reach a beginner level. On the other hand, you can expect to spend at least 3 years studying to become fluent in Japanese with near-native level accuracy.

**How many Japanese kanji do you need to know to be fluent?** To become fluent in kanji, you'll need to learn around 2,000 basic Japanese kanjis used in media and everyday Japanese life. Don't panic; once you have the first 400-500 symbols down, the rest tend to follow smoothly. You really only need around 1,200 to read a newspaper or go to work.

**What is the greeting you say when replying to the word tadaima?** "Okaerinasai ??????????" or "Okaeri ??????" are responses to Tadaima. The translation of those words is "welcome home." Tadaima and okaeri are two of the most common Japanese greetings. In fact, the order in which they are said is not important.

**Why do Japanese add extra syllables to English words?** Since Japanese syllables have a single vowel preceded by no more than one consonant, consonant clusters of foreign words have to be broken up and vowels adjoined to make them into separate syllables.

**What English words are borrowed from Japanese?** The now familiar words bento, katana, miso, mochi, sake, shogun, and tatami were all first used in English in the 1600s, and the still common words hiragana, koi, samurai, and tofu entered the language in the 1700s and early 1800s.

**What is the national dictionary of Japan?** The Nihon Kokugo Daijiten (????????), also known as the Nikkoku (??) and in English as Shogakukan's Unabridged Dictionary of the Japanese Language, is the largest Japanese language dictionary published.

**Does Japanese use Z?** Standard Japanese romanization has z in it, but strictly speaking there is only a softened /dz/ consonant instead of /z/. For example: the romanization of ????? are marked as za ji zu ze zo, but their actual pronunciations are /dza, d?i, dz?, dze, dzo/.

**What dictionary does jisho use?** JMdict, created by Jim Breen and now managed by the Electronic Dictionary Research and Development Group (EDRDG), is a great general dictionary with roughly 170 000 entries and is actively maintained by Jim Breen and a team of volunteers. This dictionary file is the source of the bulk of the words in Jisho.

Hence, through their desire to emulate the American way of life, the Japanese people began, perhaps unconsciously, to use more English words in their own language.

In this format, the characters are written in columns going from top to bottom, with columns ordered from right to left.

**What letters don't Japanese use?** Notice that several English sounds are missing from the Japanese language entirely: "c," "f," "l," "q," "v," and "x." When Japanese want to represent these sounds, they have to use Japanese syllables that sound almost the same. For example, to pronounce the country name "France," Japanese say "Huransu."

**What 3 alphabets does Japan use?** These three systems are called hiragana, katakana and kanji. If that sounds overwhelming, don't worry! Hiragana and katakana are easy enough to learn – and will be a big help if you're thinking about travelling to Japan, or learning basic Japanese. Learning kanji is a little trickier, but we'll come to that later.

**Why are so many Japanese words Chinese?** Prior to this time, Japanese was only a spoken language. Then the Japanese began using Chinese characters to transliterate their own spoken tongue. Eventually they adapted Chinese written characters to create a set of syllables, called kana, that would fit the Japanese language.
